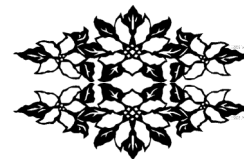

It will take place on Saturday, January 27, right after the 5 PM Mass at Saint Victor. There will be a silent auction which benefits the Fundraising Committee of Saint Victor. But the dinner is for members of both parishes, and all are welcome. The first week of ticket sales went extraordinarily well. Please pick up your tickets now in order to beat the rush next weekend.

Tickets are available after masses at Saint Victor and anytime from the Saint Victor office on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays from 9 AM until 4 PM. We hope to have a good turnout from both parishes for this favorite event.

This year Easter will fall on March 31, which is the earliest date over the ten consecutive years between 2016 and 2027. This means all of the important events which occur during Lent are right around the corner. Ash Wednesday is only four weeks away!

Our Communal Penance Service with 12 Priests on Monday, March 11, is an extremely important Lenten event, and together with the Communal Celebration of the Anointing of the Sick at 5 PM Mass on Saturday, March 16, is the “heart” of our Lenten observance.
