St. Joseph Sunday Missals Available for Both Parishes. With some reluctance we are making available for purchase several "*St. Joseph Sunday Missals*" for those who would like to have a copy of the scripture readings in their hands during the liturgy. Clearly, competent liturgical professionals are in unanimous agreement that the scriptures are to be proclaimed and actively heard, not "read along with." (At Mother of Sorrows there are missalettes, so hand missals would be duplicative and therefore not necessary.)

Liturgy is a ritual activity deeply imbedded in our humanity. It is a celebration, loosely analogous to a birthday party or a football game. Would anyone pass around song sheets for the singing of *Happy Birthday* or the *National Anthem?* To some extent, booklets, missalettes, and worse yet, digital screens such as are found in some churches, break through the "Fourth Wall" and weaken the human quality of a liturgical celebration.

Nevertheless, even with a good sound system and excellent lectors, there are some parishioners who have difficulty hearing the scriptures. Or, they might like to preview the scriptures before Mass or reflect on them afterward. So we are offering for purchase St. Joseph Sunday Missals for 2024. They will be available in the Gathering Room. Their cost is \$5.00, and there will be an envelope in each book which can be put into the collection basket.

At Saint Victor, on the first Sunday of Lent, February 18, we will begin learning a new Mass setting, "*The Mass of Christ the Savior*." It was written by Dan Schutte, a well-respected Catholic composer, who has many published works in print. We sing a lot of his music, e.g. "*Here I Am*, *Lord*," "*Beyond the Moon and Stars*," and "*Blest Be the Lord*" to name a few. Dan was one of the original members of the St. Louis Jesuits back in the 1970's. We will use the Eucharistic acclamations first during the five weeks of Lent, and initiate work on the Gloria after Easter. Herb will spend two to three minutes each week before Mass going over these new settings. There will be congregation cards in each pew for everyone to be able to participate in what we are singing.



St. Joseph Sunday Missal. In order to reduce handling, missalettes were withdrawn at Saint Victor during the height of the pandemic. An added benefit is the ability to draw from a universe of liturgical music, and not be limited to the selections of only one publisher. However recently at both Parish Council and Finance Council it was reported that some parishioners miss being able to read and follow the scriptures, and recite the Apostle's Creed. Clearly, competent liturgical professionals are in unanimous agreement that the scriptures are to be proclaimed and actively heard, not "read along with." Nevertheless, even with a good sound system, there are some parishioners who have difficulty hearing the scriptures. While not required, nor necessarily recommended, we are going to offer for purchase St. Joseph Sunday Missals for 2024. They will be available in the Gathering Room. Parishioners who wish can keep them in their car, purse or wallet for weekly reference. Their cost is \$5.00, and there will be an envelope in each book which can be put into the collection basket. We will procure a small batch and see how they go, if we need more, we will order them.
