Parish Faith Formation For All Ages

PSR/JYM. This week, Sunday, March 17th is an **AT HOME** PSR/JYM class. This means that the students are invited and expected to login at https://christinus.com/@PAR442866591 to read and complete the assignment for that week. The lesson for this week is "Triduum: Why did Jesus Die on the Cross and Rise again?" There are **no classes** the next two weekends, March 24 and March 31, 2024, as we celebrate Palm Sunday and Easter.

Stations of the Cross are prayed at Mother of Sorrows every Friday during Lent at 7:00 PM. This is a wonderful way for our two parishes to pray together during this holy season. The stations are lead by Pastoral Associate Darlene Bednarz as well as parishioners from both parishes.



Rice Bowls. After an unfortunate delay, Rice Bowls have arrived at Saint Victor and are available in the Gathering Room. Father Victor Galier preached on the Rice Bowls last year. Please recall that 25% of the contributions remain within the diocese to subsidize hunger programs.

St. Joseph Sunday Missal. While not required, nor necessarily recommended, we are going to offer for purchase St. Joseph Sunday Missals for 2024. They will be available in Saint Victor's Gathering Room. Their cost is \$5.00, and there will be an envelope in each book which can be put into the collection basket. If we need more, we will order them.

Dear People of God,

The Sacred Triduum is being celebrated for both parishes at Saint Victor Church. The Sacred Triduum is the Church's celebration of the Paschal Mystery; it is the object of all of our preparation during the six weeks of Lent. The three movements of the Sacred Triduum, which take place on three successive days, form one, unified liturgy, which begins with the Greeting of the Mass of the Lord's Supper and ends with the Blessing and Dismissal of the Easter Vigil. The Celebration of the Passion of the Lord begins and concludes in silence and without ceremony. That is because none of these three movements stand alone; they are three parts of one whole act of worship.

The Mass of the Lord's Supper. Holy Thursday, March 28, at 7 PM. This mass includes the "Washing of the Feet" and ends with a solemn procession of reservation for the Blessed Sacrament. The collection for Holy Thursday's Mass of the Lord's Supper will be taken up for the ministry of the Saint Victor chapter of the Saint Vincent de Paul Society.

The Celebration of the Lord's Passion. Good Friday, March 29, at 3 PM. This rite includes the proclamation of the Passion According to John and the Veneration of the Cross. While this is not a mass, it does include the Lord's Prayer and a Communion Procession. The collection basket for Good Friday is particularly dedicated to the Holy Lands of the Pope.

The Easter Vigil. Holy Saturday, March 30, at 7:30 PM. This includes the Blessing of the Easter Fire and the singing of the Easter Proclamation. There is an extended Liturgy of the Word and usually the Baptism of the Elect. This year we do not have any baptisms, but we do have one Reception into the Catholic Faith and Confirmation.

Important Project for Mother of Sorrows
Building Fund. Many Mother of Sorrows parishioners have had the opportunity to tour all of the parish buildings, including the rectory. It is clear that there was a need for extensive professional, commercial cleaning. The project is now completed. Parishioners are asked to consider generous contributions to the Building Fund of Mother of Sorrows so that projects of this type can be completed without necessitating deficit spending. Every dollar contributed to the Building Fund remains at the parish, and is not assessed by the diocese. Thank you very much for your generosity.

Faith Direct. Despite the leadership transition for Mother of Sorrows, the two MoS funds of the Saint Victor Faith Direct e-Giving portal will remain in place under the supervision of both Parish Accountants, Lydia and Stanley. This will continue for the foreseeable future, pending review by the parish leadership and Finance Councils. There are at least ten MoS households enrolled in Faith Direct, and there is no reason to interrupt that vital revenue stream prematurely.

Mass of Christ Our Savior. Thanks to Herb Dillahunt for helping us all learn the new mass setting for Saint Victor. It seems to be going quite well, although quite obviously I'm still learning my parts. Since the Glory to God is not used during Lent, we have not yet learned it. Herb will begin introducing this on the Second Sunday of Easter. Please make use of the congregation cards that are available in the pews.
