Did You Know?

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton is the founder of the Sisters of Charity of St. Joseph and considered the founder of the Catholic School system in the US. She was a charming young woman in New York City, linked to all the first families. At the age of 19, she married the wealthy William Magee Seton. The two had a very happy marriage, raising five children. Ten years after they were married, William's business and health both failed, and Elizabeth was left a poor widow with five children to raise alone. Her love for the Eucharist led her to convert to Catholicism and she founded the first order of religious women in America, the Sisters of Charity of St. Joseph. She was able to still raise her children, as well as live the life of a Sister and found several schools. She became the co-founder of the first free Catholic School in America.

Hello to My Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Easter! HE HAS RISEN!!! I would like to share this thought with you. It is simple but is not necessarily easy.

"I am the good shepherd...and I lay down my life for the sheep...and they will heed my voice."- John 10:14-16

As we continue our Easter journey, we might consider the following. When we pray, do we only ask Jesus for the things that we want? Do we ever ask Jesus what He wants for us and from us? How do we listen for His response? Many times, Jesus responds in "quiet whispers" that are not so obvious. So, take time every day to step away from the noise, TV, radio, internet, cell phone and the constant noise of our world. Find a quiet place. And be intentional and actively listen for His voice. You will be surprised to hear what our Lord has to say to us in the silence.

I was so happy to hear that we had a full house for the Easter service. My hope is that we make that a weekly occurrence. We will need everyone's help.
