

Much of what we know about St. Mark, the author of the Second Gospel, comes largely from the New Testament and early Christian traditions. Mark the Evangelist is believed to be the 'John Mark' referred to in the Acts of the Apostles. Mark joined St. Paul and St. Barnabas on their first missionary journey to Antioch in 44 A.D. When Paul was first imprisoned, Mark visited him as one of his trusted companions. According to Christian tradition, Mark also held a close relationship with St. Peter, who referred to Mark has 'his son'. Mark had not personally heard the Lord speak and he was not one of the twelve apostles. His Gospel was based upon the teachings of St. Peter. It is believed Mark provided both Luke and Matthew with basic sources for their Gospels. St. Mark's symbol is a winged lion. He is often depicted as writing or holding his Gospel. St. Mark is the patron saint of Venice. His feast day is celebrated on April 25.
