OTHER PARISH INFORMATION


REGISTRATION: If you are new or have not yet registered, please register in person or call during office hours. If you are moving, please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible.



St. Damien de Veuster of Moloka'l' cared for the physical, medical, and spiritual needs of those exiled to the leper colony on the Hawaiian island of Moloka'l in the 1800s. His life of service shed light on the effects of this devastating disease and allowed people to see those afflicted with it with more compassion and love.

Born Joseph de Veuster in Belgium, he quit school at 13 to work on the family farm. Feeling called for more, he entered the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary six years later, where he took the name of a fourthcentury physician and martyr, Damien. His brother, a priest from the same congregation, fell ill and was unable to go to his assigned location. Damien volunteered in his place and found himself on the Hawaiian Islands in 1864. Two months after arriving, he was ordained a priest of Honolulu and assigned to the Island of Hawaii. He visited the Hawaiian government's leper colony on the island of Moloka'l, where he petitioned to stay permanently to care for their physical, medical, and spiritual needs. He found strength to endure isolation and disease in Eucharistic adoration and the celebration of the Mass. He was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on October 11, 2009.
